- **Injury Prevention Support Activities for 2010 – Deb Braun**

Dale has spoken with Sharon Rhyne of NC Public Health, who will be sending a list of potential conferences to Dale. Ms. Rhyne noted that many injury prevention groups have significantly scaled back or postponed their conferences this year.

The group discussed the injury prevention scholarships. NC ATS will fund up to four grants with a maximum of \$1,500 each. These grants will focus specifically on injury prevention activities. Dale has been working with Ethiel Estes to revise the scholarship application, and will have the information posted on the NC ATS web site by the end of January. The NC ATS executive committee will review the scholarship applications. The goal is to announce the awardees at the April 2010 NC ATS meeting.
