

New Business

- **National ATS meeting – Gail Kluttz**

Gail reported that the upcoming National ATS meeting will focus upon data management. Additionally, National is revamping its chapter reporting, and Gail has been asked to consider taking responsibility for the state ATS chapters.

The Second Trauma program is managed by the Trauma Survivors' Network, and has not been emphasized among the state chapters.

Debra P. offered a motion that Gail should attend the National meeting in order to represent our chapter, discuss the Second Trauma program and discover how any new ATS requirements may affect our chapter. The motion was seconded by Linda. The motion was adopted.

- **Injury prevention activities – Deb Braun**

Deb suggested to the group that the chapter try to offer more support to injury prevention activities across the state. She suggested that NC ATS have a representative at the larger injury prevention conferences in the state, such as UNC or the Child Passenger Safety conference. Linda suggested that the chapter develop a display board showing scholarships and injury prevention activities. After some discussion, the group agreed that NC ATS will seek out opportunities to share information at state injury prevention conferences.

- **New meeting schedule – Deb Braun**

Given the difficulty with scheduling and travel, Deb suggested to the group that the chapter consider holding two meetings per year in person, and two via teleconference. Meetings will still coincide with the STAC meetings. Gail offered a motion that the January and July NC ATS meetings be held via teleconference and the April and October meetings be held in person in High Point. Dale seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.
